SPORTS MEDICINE AS Degree and Transfer Preparation

The associate in science degree in sports medicine is a two year course of study designed for students interested in becoming various allied health care professionals such as athletic trainers, physical therapists, physical therapists assistants, chiropractic care, occupational therapy, physician assistant etc. It provides academic and clinical experience to prepare students for further study or to obtain employment in an entry level rehabilitation and/or allied health setting. Earning this degree may facilitate the student's transfer to a four-year college and/or professional program. Career Opportunities in Sports Medicine: The study of the associate of science degree in sports medicine prepares students for careers into professional programs such as allied health, athletic training, physical therapy, physician assisting and sports medicine. The program of study and clinical opportunities may facilitate the students for transfer to a four year college and/ or professional program.
