

PREVENTION OF IDENTITY THEFT IN STUDENT FINANCIAL TRANSACTIONS

The District is required to provide for the identification, detection, and response to patterns, practices, or specific activities ("Red Flags") that could indicate theft of students' identities. Because the District serves as a creditor in relation to its students, the Superintendent/President is directed to develop procedures as required by law to implement an Identity Theft Prevention Program (ITPP) to control reasonably foreseeable risks to students from identity theft.
