Desert Community College District has previously issued its \$57,850,000 of General Obligation Bonds, Election of 2004, Series 2007B (the "2007 Bonds"). Upon the issuance of the 2007 Bonds, the District, Riverside County and U.S. Bank National Association (Fiscal Agent) entered into a Fiscal Agent Agreement, dated December 20, 2007, regarding the investment of proceeds of the 2007 Bonds. The proceeds of the 2007 Bonds were invested by the Fiscal Agent in accordance with the terms of the 2007 Agreement. In 2013 and 2015, the District directed the transfer of the unspent proceeds of the 2007 Bonds held by the Fiscal Agent to the County Treasurer's Pooled Investment Fund, which resulted in the termination of the 2007 Agreement. The County Treasurer currently holds the proceeds of the 2007 Bonds. The District desires to reinvest the proceeds of the 2007 Bonds with the Fiscal Agent pursuant to the advice of Bond Counsel and District's independent investment advisor. The District desires to direct the County Treasurer to re-deposit the proceeds of the 2007 Bonds with the Fiscal Agent pursuant to the terms of a new Fiscal Agent Agreement by and among the District, the County and the Fiscal Agent.
