#### **BACKGROUND:**

Pursuant to Public Contract Code 20118, college districts may participate in outside purchasing agreements if it is determined to be in the best interest of the District. The Biggs Unified School District has stipulated the use of this bid by other districts by virtue of its 'piggyback' clause.

Biggs Unified School District advertised for the purchase of High Performance Modular structures. At its December 13, 2011 Board of Trustees meeting, approval was granted to award American Modular Systems as the lowest responsive responsible bidder. The performance period was one year commencing December 13, 2011 and could be renewed on an annual basis for up to five additional one-year periods. Biggs approved subsequent annual extensions including price increases as provided for in the terms and conditions. This bid is currently valid until December 12, 2016.

The proposed Purchase Order in the amount of \$937,088.00 includes the construction and installation of four (4) new modular structures for the East Valley Campus- Mecca Thermal Expansion Project. These modular structures include two (2) classrooms, one (1) interdisciplinary lab and one (1) lab prep room. The contractor for this purchase order is American Modular Systems. All further onsite scopes of work will follow the normal public bid process.
