

COVID-19 Screening and Reporting Process for Hybrid Students



Upon entering campus, students will:

- Stop at a specifically identified College of the Desert entrance to be screened with the SWAY Medical App (Symptom Checker App).
- If a student passes the symptom checker, they will be given a wristband and allowed to enter campus.
 - Should a student report to class without a wristband, they will be re-directed to the check-in location.
- If a student does not pass the symptom checker, they may be denied access to campus for the day.

If a student does not pass the symptom checker, a COVID-19 Reporting Team Member will:

- Notify the student's instructor of the absence by email.
- Contact the student for more information and to follow-up on symptoms.
- On behalf of the student, the COVID-19 Reporting Team Member will fill out the online COVID-19 Reporting Form, located on the Faculty/Staff Portal, if necessary.
- A member of the COVID-19 Reporting Team will determine a date in which the student will be allowed to return to campus.
 - One business day prior to the return date, the student will be contacted to do a COVID-19 symptoms check over the phone.
 - o All criteria must be met before the student will be allowed to return to campus.
