## INDECENT EXPOSURE REPORTED

On Monday, May 22, 2017, at 10:30 AM, a female student reported that while she was parking her vehicle in Lot 28, she became aware of an unknown male subject who parked next to her on her passenger side. After a verbal exchange the male subject exposed his genitals to the female student.
