**ESLN 310A** is the Level I (low-beginning) ESL course introducing students to basic structures of functional American English and stresses the simple present and present continuous tenses in reading, writing, listening and speaking. Prerequisite: ESLN 309A, or self-placement, or instructor recommendation. Students receive a Pass/No Pass grade mark.

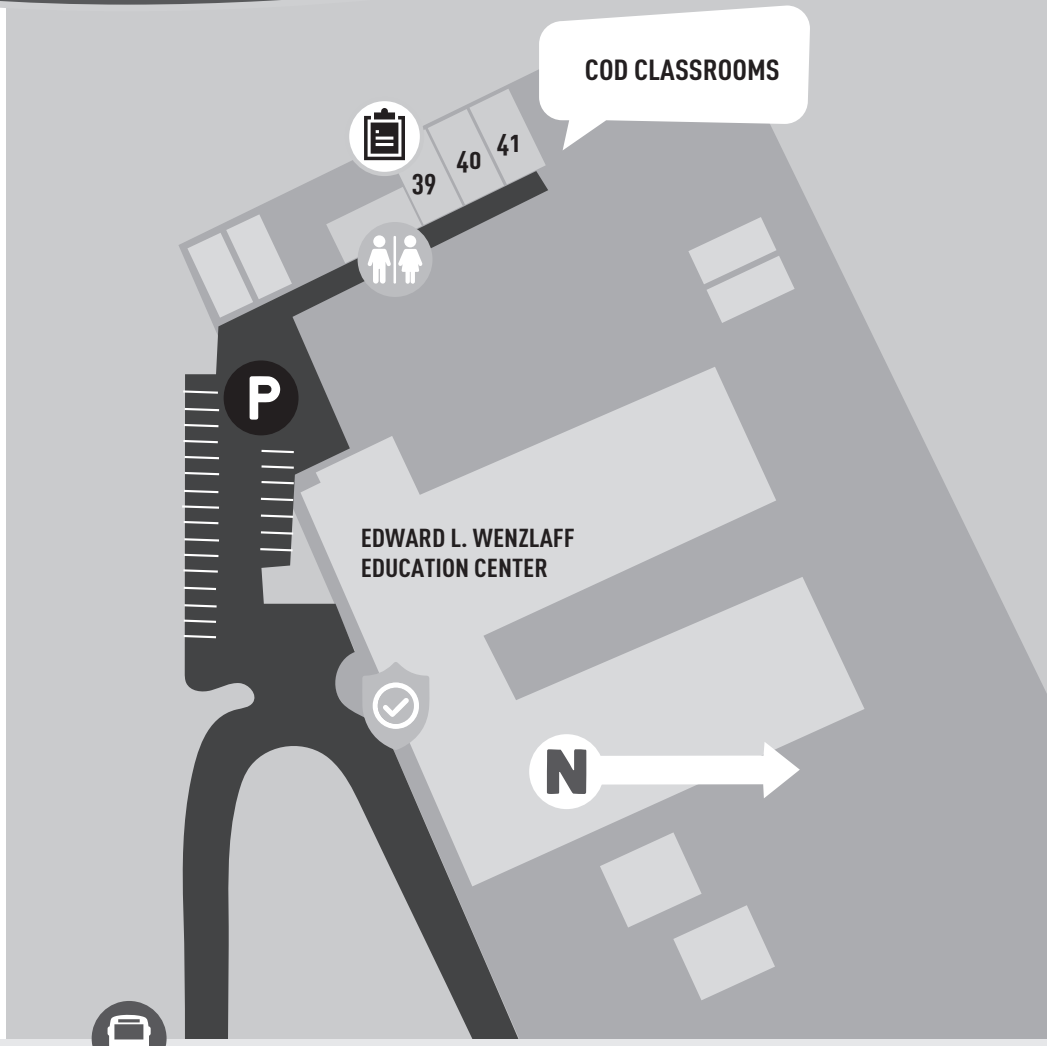
