- J. Falcon moved to edit strike "4" to "5" which was seconded by F. Robles which was approved 11-1.
- Voting passed unanimously to strike and add the amendment to insert, "ASCOD Student Senate will approve members who have reach the threshold of 5 absences of today's date and will be removed if they miss one more meeting".
