2. Faculty Report

2.1 Recycling:

- Would like to see a standard for trash and recycling bins for all campuses.
- Provide signage and an educational recycling campaign to include anything that is recyclable; for example, cans, bottles, plastic, paper cardboard, comingle.
- GIS Application: Candace Weber showed a mapping tool using a
 GIS software where a student went around the campus and mapped
 out and took photos of every single recycling and trash bins
 including bicycle racks and water fill up stations. It was done

- approximately a year ago. It is a visual collection of what is on campus in terms of our recycling efforts.
- There are other community colleges that have an actual recycling center.
- Provide a video about recycling on campus as part of the students' registration process.
- Provide recycling information to the Board of Trustees on what we are doing.
- Update the Sustainability Council website.
- Include articles in the Chaparral school newspaper.

3. Other Business

- 3.1 Electric Car Plug-in Stations
 - There is only one station located by the Nursing Building on the
 Palm Desert campus that was provided by The City of Palm Desert.
 - Would like to have more stations installed on campus and possibly at the other campuses too.
 - Need to check to see if we can get a grant.
 - Maybe partner with SunLine Transit or General Motors.
 - Maybe receive donations from the California Alliance for Renewable Energy or Wintec Energy.
 - It was discussed and decided to send out a survey with only three questions regarding electric car plug-in stations to students, staff and faculty.
