- 2.2 Climate Change by Dr. Cameron Barrows: Dr. Cameron Barrows was the special guest today and he talked about the many evidence we have to support Climate Change. Barrows showed us slides on how impactful we

have been on adding CO2 to our ecosystem. The last slide was about how we can improve our ecosystem by supporting affordable roof solar, sustainable landscapes – reduce imported water footprints, support open space – parks and wildlife habitat, plant more (native) trees in areas – more shade = cooler temperatures, eliminate lawns, landscape with native plants, landscape including food plants, control invasive plants (tamarisk, fountain grass, etc) that degrade wildlife values in potential climate refugia, and rob water from native species, support reduce carbon energy and much more.
