A student population of 2,400 from around the world enjoys the benefit of a variety of student organizations and activities on campus.


# STUDY ABROAD WITH STUDY TOURS AND EXCHANGE PROGRAMS






# **DEGREE OPTIONS**

# FINANCIAL AID & SCHOLARSHIPS

### **FINANCIAL AID**

Eligible students may apply for all federal financial assistance programs at FAFSA.gov. California residents: FIDM is an approved college for Cal Grants A, B, and C.

### **SCHOLARSHIPS**

Scholarship money is available for new and current FIDM Students. Scholarships are offered based on a varying combination of qualities such as academic merit, financial need, industry experience, artistic achievement, and club affiliations.

Scholarship recipients are expected to be particularly strong and positive leaders while in attendance at FIDM, excelling academically and representing FIDM well within the community. Many scholarships are determined through review of Admissions application materials. Certain competitive scholarships have additional requirements.

Scholarships are subject to change. Some scholarships are awarded for the first year only. Many scholarships are renewable for up to 4 years by maintaining a 3.0 GPA, consecutive attendance, and 12 units quarterly at FIDM. Students may qualify for more than one scholarship but not to exceed the cost of tuition, books, and supplies.

While Student Housing is not a dorm, we do manage the individual units within the privately owned and operated apartment properties. All housing units are 2-bedroom, 2-bath premium apartments and conveniently located. Private rooms are available at double the cost.
